USING BLEACH SAFELY

Bleach (also called chlorine bleach, *Javel Water* or sodium hypochlorite) should not be mixed with other household chemical products because hazardous gases, heat, or explosions may result...

It is most safely mixed only with water. It should never be mixed with:



AMMONIA in glass/ floor cleaners, wax remover etc.




ACIDS such as vinegar, some toilet, tile and concrete cleaners, some drain unblockers, soft drinks such as cola/ lemon juices



ALCOHOLS including alcoholic beverages, or **ACETONE** nail polish removers



HYDROGEN PEROXIDE and other oxygen-based bleaches/ stain removers



OTHER DISINFECTANTS and **CLEANERS** based on quaternary ammonium or chlorine



FUELS, OILS, BRAKE FLUIDS and ANTIFREEZE

Always use these in well ventilated spaces...
...if in doubt, check the bottle label before you pour!
